ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Cemetery Survey, Maintenance Update and Huntley Cemetery Beautification Project

The FY14 Beautification Project was discussed. It has been realized that a grave plot is concerningly close to where the stone columns are being proposed. Board members discussed talking to the family about moving the existing burial to elsewhere in the cemetery. It was decided to wait on beginning the project until we can have a proper survey done of the area to make sure that all elements of the project will work. It was also decided to wait to remove the trees, etc. until the project started. Village Clerk McMahon said she would talk to the Village's engineering firm to conduct a proper survey of the cemetery regarding the right-of-way, etc for the project.

Board members discussed the color of the stone for the columns. It was decided to use a color called Chilson, which is a brownish/red color, for the column and Fon du lac, which is a cream, for the top cap.
