- All will certainly have homecoming spirit after attending the parade and pep rally which will include a performance by the bands and cheerleaders and meeting the coach and football team!

Downtown Plan Complete

The Downtowntown Revitalization Plan was completed in September. The Downtown Plan offers many exciting opportunities that reinforce the downtown as the community's gathering place - the cultural, commercial, and civic "heart" of the Village. The purpose of the planning process has been to reconfirm and reinforce the Village's commitment to ensuring the long-term viability of the core of the Village. The plan is not "etched in stone". It purposefully includes options so that when redevelopment opportunities are presented all relevant conditions can be reviewed and explored.

The following 8 fundamental goals of the Downtown Plan are aimed at providing opportunities for living, shopping, business, recreation and leisure in downtown Huntley:

- 1) Create a vibrant, active, mixed-use, pedestrian oriented environment in the Downtown.
- 2) Achieve a balance between preservation and new development in the Downtown.
- 3) Improve the Downtown's "sense of place".
- 4) Enhance the mobility, movement and safety of pedestrian, vehicular and bicycle traffic in the Downtown.
- 5) Provide a diverse housing inventory and living environment that complements the quality, scale and character of existing homes in the Downtown and supports Downtown businesses.
- 6) Revitalize existing commercial areas/businesses in the Downtown through redevelopment, appropriate rehabilitation, adaptive reuse, and public improvements.
- 7) Ensure the appropriate location and provision of community facilities, services and infrastructure throughout the Village and Downtown.
- 8) Improve the appearance and functionality of existing industrial uses in the Downtown and/or support their relocation to designated industrial/business parks elsewhere in the Village.

Huntley Strategic Plan

The Village Board is nearing completion of a Strategic Plan. The plan identifies the Village's mission, values, and vision for the future. As part of the planning process, the Village conducted a resident survey to seek public input. The plan also includes an analysis of strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats, as well as demographic and financial data. Goals and objectives have been developed that will be used to formulate one-year action plans to be incorporated into the Village's annual budget document. Dear Residents,

The Village was sure a busy place this summer! The Police Department achieved CALEA Accreditation, held a Teen Safety Camp and assisted several neighborhoods become "Neighborhood Watch" areas. Village sponsored road improvement projects completed include the Brier Hill Road resurfacing, Reed Road Improvements from Haligus Road to Cambridge Drive and the 2010 Annual Street Improvement Program that included a portion of the Southwind Subdivision and Grove Street.

Even during these tough economic times, Huntley remains a leader as a great place to live. New residential building permits are on the rise with 73 new starts through August (52 units had been permitted through this period in 2009). The farmers' market has seen record vendor participation and our residents are enjoying all the great fruits, vegetables, and non-produce items weekly.

The Route 47 Widening Project is well underway and we thank everyone for their patience during this Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) project. As IDOT gives us updates on the construction, we try to keep you informed by posting the latest news on our website so please check it often. I encourage all Huntley residents to keep supporting our local businesses and be sure to allow plenty of time to travel through the Village. Open Burning Ordinance

Although Huntley is located in 2 counties, Huntley's Village Board adopted the McHenry County Open Burning Ordinance to cover ALL property within the Village. Due to the relatively small size of residential lots in Huntley, leaf burning is essentially illegal for the vast majority of homeowners within Village limits. Route 47 Construction

The 2 year project is well underway, with this year's construction season anticipated to last through October.
